**Terms and conditions for the Guest Faculty to be engaged on contract basis**

1. **Period of engagement** :The period of engagement under this offer shall be for a fixed period w.e.f. 01.04.2022 to 31.07.2022 in Central Sanskrit University
2. **Remuneration**: You will be entitled for a fixed consolidated and an all inclusive remuneration @Rs.40000/- (Rupees forty thousand only) maximum per month (for minimum of 40 hours per month)
3. **Medical Fitness Certificate**: You will have to produce medical fitness certificate from the Registered Medical Practitioner certifying that you are medically fit for rendering your services in the University.
4. **Leave**: You will be entitled for 6 days casual leave per semester on prorata basis for the said period of engagement and will not be entitled for any other kind of leave.
5. This engagement is made purely on temporary and contract basis for fixed period.
6. You will not be entitled to any other benefit such as Confirmation, LTC, Medical reimbursement, etc. which is admissible to the regular employees of the University.
7. You will have no claim for regularization/seniority on the basis of this engagement.
